

Professional Services Available

For the first time women's teams are having access to professional services, i.e. physicians and trainers.

At the University of Wisconsin, Madison we recently followed Jody Dickens, the trainer for the volleyball team and Jan Tappan, the trainer for the field hockey team from the time the teams came into the training room until the games were over.

The trainers work under the supervision of Dr. Peter Hanson of the University Health Service and Gordon Stoddard the head trainer for the University.

Each girl has attended the trainers' clinics which were held at Oshkosh this summer and both of them hope to become certified professional trainers when they have completed their educations. To accomplish this they must serve 1,800 hours under an accredited trainer or attain their masters degree and serve 900 hours under an accredited trainer.

Jody Dickens is a junior, physical education major from Madison. She anticipates going on to graduate school and says her interest has always been strong in this area.

Jan Tappan is a senior from Menominee, Wisconsin and also intends to pursue her masters. She wants to work professionally as a trainer and says there is a great demand for women in this field.

There is a great demand for professional women trainers and when the rigorous training period is over and armed with masters degrees neither Jody nor Jan should have any difficulty moving into professional sports.
