The trainers work under the supervision of Dr. Peter Hanson of the University Health Service and Gordon Stoddard the head trainer for the University.

Each girl has attended the trainers clinics which were held at Oshkosh this summer and both of them hope to become certified professional trainers when they have completed their educations. To accomplish this they must serve 1,800 hours under an accredited trainer or attain their masters degree and serve 900 hours under an accredited trainer.

Jody Dickens is a junior, physical education major from Madison. She anticipates going on to graduate school and says her interest has always been strong in this area.

Jan Tappan is a senior from Menominee, Wisconsin and also intends to pursue her masters. She wants to work professionally as a trainer and says there is a great demand for women in this field.


